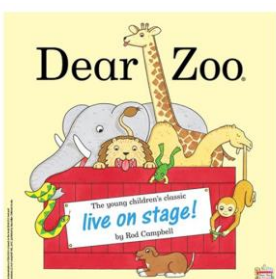
Unfortunately Mrs. Baxter is currently unwell and will be away all week and the class will be taken by Mrs. Kedge, who was with them on Tuesday.

## Singing Lessons
