If your child plays football at one of our After School Clubs we would be very grateful if boots could be cleaned between sessions to save the dried mud being spread around in school. Thank you!

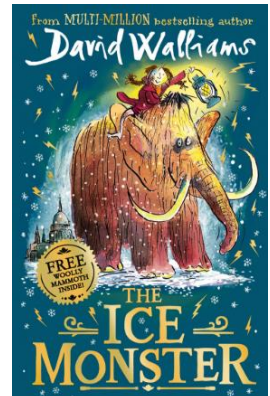
## Book of the Week
