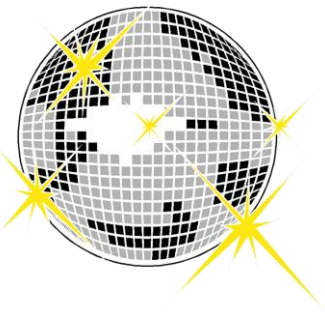

The proofs of the individual photos are coming home this evening, please make sure all orders are back to school by this **Friday 9th November.**

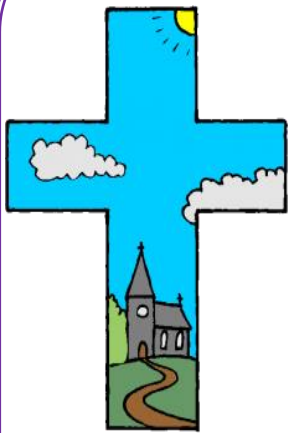
