## Uniform orders for new Intake

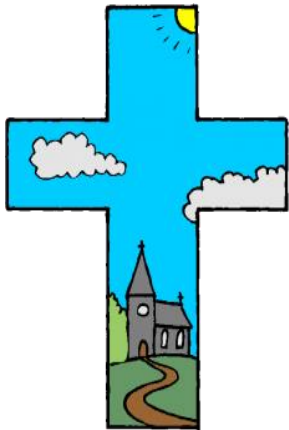
