But also:

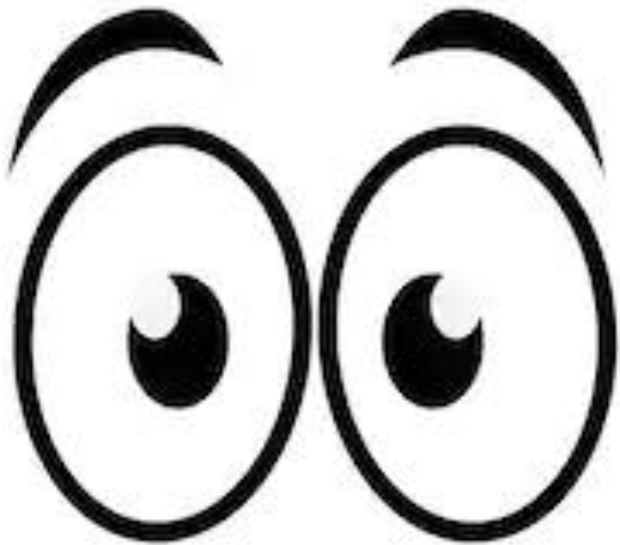
➤ Never cross a road while looking at a phone

- And it helps you be seen by cars and pedestrians

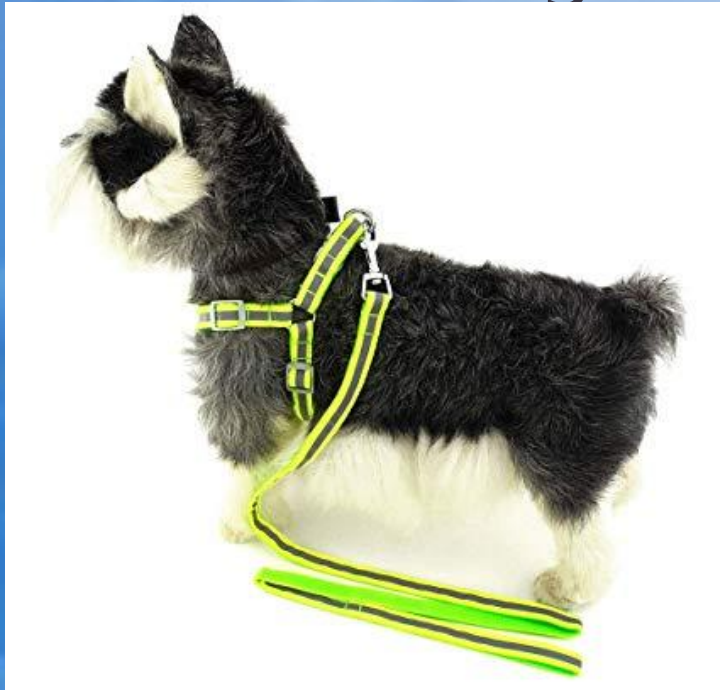
Also make sure your tyres are pumped up and brakes are working
